

TREATMENT AREA: The pre-stressed concrete water tank was still under construction when this aerial was taken. It will hold water from the pipeline for distribution to the treatment ponds. In the top photo, some of the waterproof liner for the treatment ponds is seen with the now completed water tank in the background. Treatment cells, No. 1 to 3 are scheduled for start-up and testing in November 2024. Cells No. 4 to 6 will follow in February, 2025.


