

GENEVA RESTORATION UPDATE

The Geneva Restoration team continues to meet weekly to keep everything moving along. Representatives from SJRWMD, Clay County, the City of Keystone Heights, SOLO and our consultant are in attendance. Here is the status as of 5/28/25:

- 1. Clay County has had a survey crew on the Geneva lakebed for the last week or so. They are marking trees at the 102.9 ft. elevation with orange paint or flagging tape in addition to stakes. **PLEASE** do not disturb any of the survey markings. Those marked trees will **not** be removed but are marked to show the sovereign land boundary and where tree removal will start. Other trees such as cypress located below the102.9 ft. elevation will be marked and will not be removed. Cypress trees survive in water. If you are aware of a cypress tree that does not get flagged, please contact SOLO (save-our-lakes@comcast.net).
- 2. Clay County and the City of Keystone Heights are working together to move the Restoration Project along. From surveying, the letting of the contract to final completion of the Restoration Project, Clay County, the City of Keystone Heights, SJRWMD and SOLO will have feet on the ground. All Ts are being crossed and is dotted to make sure this is a successful Restoration. As of our last meeting (5/27/25), the actual removal is expected to begin in late July.

BLACK CREEK PROJECT - GOOD NEWS/BAD NEWS

Good news first – Of the six treatment cells, cells 1 and 2 are completed, tested and ready to go. Cell 3 is nearing completion and will be ready for testing shortly. Cells 4, 5 and 6 are in progress.

Now for the bad news. Mother nature has not been our friend. Our normal dry season has lasted longer than normal and summer rains have yet to begin. The Water District had anticipated releasing Black Creek water into Alligator Creek "before June". While at least two cells are ready to release, Black Creek flow is not sufficient to allow pumping (as of 5/28/25).

Back to good news – this is **EXACTLY** how the Black Creek Water Resource Project is supposed to work! The pumping and pipeline capacity is designed to send 10mgd (million gallons a day) to Alligator Creek with an **AVERAGE** of 7.5mgd. The Project design allows for dry periods and **protects Black Creek**. We have asked the Water District for some specific Black Creek pumps on/off data and will provide that information when available.

As always, we will keep you updated!
