A VERY SUCCESSFUL LAKE GENEVA CLEANUP EVENT!

On April 26 (Saturday from 9-12), SOLO sponsored a Lake Geneva Cleanup event to prepare the lakebed for the upcoming Lake Geneva Restoration Project. We had a great turnout of about forty folks at the 5th Street boat ramp. Everyone came prepared for work and work they did! Commissioner Betsy Condon also came to lend her support!

K.H. Engineer James Booth had scouted the area around the boat ramp and provided good directions for everyone. Thanks to Denmark Builders, LLC for providing a commercial size dumpster and Ken Massey for bringing his red tractor to provide hauling support.

Lake Geneva has been used by some as their own personal dumping ground! Here are a few of the things we found and put in the dumpster:

A pile of dried sakrete bags, mattress/boxsprings, carpet pile, tires (4 with rims on them), heavy gauge wire, metal chair frame, fertilizer bags, pile of wood with attached metal angle

With the unauthorized release of water from the western lobes of the lake significantly raising the main body of the lake, an additional group of trees has been killed. The timber harvester works in of a maximum of 3 ft of water, potentially leaving a hazardous condition for future boaters.
